



Dear New Adventures families and campers,

Welcome to New Adventures Summer Camp (Monday, July 19 – Friday, July 23, 2021)! I am really looking forward to a fun and action-packed camp session this summer. Here is some information to get prepared for camp. You will also find an attached camper's checklist, so you know what to bring each day.

Each day, we will be meeting at a different county park, and experiencing traditional summer camp activities, such as games, crafts, hikes and more! Here is our drop off/pick up location schedule for the week:

Thursday, 7/22	9:00 am	noon	Battle Creek Nature Center (picnic pavilion)
Friday, 7/23	9:00 am	noon	Kings Landing Park (pavilion 1)

**For Flag Ponds, when you arrive in the morning there may be a line at the front gate. Please be sure to stop at the entrance station. DO NOT enter the park through the outgoing gate. We will wait for all campers before starting our first activity.*

We will be conducting camper **health screens** each morning at drop-off. Campers must remain with their parent, in their vehicles until 9 am, and then be escorted by a parent to the check-in location. You will need to sign your camper in and out each day. Please plan to remain with your camper until the check in and health screen process is completed. Campers will be required to **wear a mask** if indoors during camp. Masks are not required outdoors.

It is essential that we receive your camper's **health forms** NO LATER THAN one week before the first day of camp (7/11/21). Please indicate if your camper has any mental or physical health concerns (severe allergies, diabetes, asthma, etc.) that may impact them at camp. If

your camper needs medication or carries a rescue medication (EpiPen, asthma inhaler, etc.) please be sure to have the proper forms completed.

Your camper should bring a hearty **daily snack**, and arrive with pre-applied **sunscreen and insect repellent** each morning. Please check your camper carefully for **ticks** after each day's camp session.

Each day, we will be outside doing many fun activities where we may get wet or messy. Campers should wear **old, comfortable clothes** that can get dirty. In addition, **sturdy, closed-toed shoes** (NO Crocs or Flip Flops) are a must since we will be walking a lot. On the first day of camp, each camper should bring an **extra change of clothes and socks** in a labeled ziplock bag that we will keep on-site for the week.

Camp will go on **rain or shine**, so please make sure your camper is dressed appropriately for the weather.
